DIRECTIONS: From Tri City Airport: Take I-81 South towards Knoxville then exit at Exit 57-B onto I-26 also called I-181 to Kingsport, then 3 miles to Exit 51 and the hotel is on the right.

From the Hampton Inn to Pinnacle Ranch.

Turn LEFT onto S JOHN B DENNIS HWY/TN-93 S. Continue to follow TN-93 S.

Merge onto I-26 W/JAMES H QUILLEN PKWY/US-23 N. Take the US-11W/W STONE DR exit, EXIT 1.

Turn LEFT onto W STONE DR/US-11W S/TN-1 W. At a traffic light -Turn LEFT onto NETHERLAND INN RD.

Turn RIGHT onto CANNONGATE RD. Follow Canongate to the end of the road. You will see Rotherwood Stables – This is NOT the place – turn right onto Holly Lane which is a gravel road. Follow the gravel road to the end. You may need to park along the gravel road and walk up to the barn and arena.

CLOTHING: We will be in an indoor arena. July can be warm and it sometimes rains.
