Directions-

From Cleveland Hopkins take 480 East towards Youngstown. Follow to 422 East towards Youngstown and Solon--- Take 422 to Parkman Ohio and turn left at Route 528. Take 528 North to Route 87.--- To get to farm turn right on 87, go 2.5 miles to Bundysburg Rd and turn right. South Farm is .5 miles on East or left side of road.

To get to Red Maple Inn, turn left on 87 and go thru Middlefield, continue on 87 to Burton, go $\frac{3}{4}$ around circle and head South on 700, the Red Maple Inn is on the left side.

To get to Bass Lake Inn, take Route 422 to 44, get off exit and go North. (turn left) Take 44 North about 15 minutes over route 87, 322 and continue north, Bass Lake Inn will be on left side of road.

Clothing: June 11-13, 2008 in North Easter Ohio is typically warm in the day 70's to low 80's and cooler at night. We have indoor arena and lounge area that is covered. Sometime if hiking the ground can be wet or middy, you might bring one pir f mick bots.

This area is rich in Amish culture; it is the 4h largest settlement in the world. There are a few shops that are very close by and have inexpensive items to purchase. There are a few parks near by that have excellent hiking trails, and of course there are many points of interest in nearby Cleveland that is about a 1 hour drive.
