From Airport to Comfort Suites: From the airport, take I-80 east towards Salt Lake City. Take the I-215 North to Ogden. The I-215 will merge onto Northbound I-15 towards Ogden. You will be traveling on I-15 for about 30 miles. From I-15 take UT-104/21ST STREET exit **343**. Turn Right on 21st Street, then take another right at 1100 W and then a right onto Wilson Lane Rd. Follow Wilson Lane Rd around to the Comfort Suites.

Directions to facility from Comfort Suites: Follow Wilson Lane Rd out to 1100W and turn left. Turn left again on 21st Street and follow underneath the freeway until you come to 1900 west or SR126. There will be a stoplight. Turn right at 1900 West. You will be heading north. Go to 1800 north. It will be the second stoplight. Approximately 3 miles. At 1800 north turn left. You will be heading west. Stay on that road. At approximately 3 miles you will come to a Chevron Convenience Store on the right at 4100 West. You are getting close. Continue going west. My house is the 6th house from the Convenience Store on the same side of the road. It has a white vinyl fence in the front. It is the only house that sets back off the road. There is a paved driveway and it will say KEELER on the mailbox.

Clothing: It can be very cold in March. Wear layers. Remember to bring gloves, hat and warm boots. We will be in an indoor arena. There will be a wood-burning stove in the observation room, but it can still get cold when working with the horses.
