Participants will...

- Examine and join in on the functions of operating a private practice which includes “traditional” psychotherapy and the EAGALA model.
- Practice alongside our Equine Assisted Psychotherapy team, shadowing as assessments, treatment goals and interventions are developed consistent with EAGALA philosophies.
- Enhance creative design and development of clinically appropriate EAP exercises.
- Assist with every aspect of daily operations of our out-patient program including farm, horse, office, and self care. (and the consistently predictable farm emergencies)
- Gather ideas and receive personal consultation for developing your own practice which includes the EAGALA model for equine assisted psychotherapy.
- Observe and gather resources for addressing liability, confidentiality, insurance reimbursement, patient billing, consents for treatment and numerous other items essential to building a successful practice.
- Strengthen your EAGALA team skills partnering with us as new EAP interventions are role played or integrated into clinical services.
- Sharpen processing skills, maximizing clinical benefits of EAP through case staffing of actual EAP exercises (contingent upon appropriate patient consent).

Requirements for Participation

- Must possess EAGALA certification
- Must submit completed CEAFS, Inc. application for ‘Classic Internship’ and \$20.00 non-refundable application fee.
- Clinicians must be in “Good Standing with Professional Licensure boards and present proof of professional liability coverage.
- Equine specialist must meet EAGALA standards for participation as a “team” partner in EAGALA model EAP.
- Internship program fess must be paid in full 14 days prior to scheduled rotation. (Change of scheduled dates, rotation length, or cancellations will be assessed \$100 fee. Refunds require applicants to cancel 10 days prior to scheduled rotation. Cancellation within 10 days of rotation is subject to 50% refund only).
- Participants are encouraged to come as teams; however, individuals may attend alone or custom consultations available.
