Single Subject Research Protocol

The EAGALA Model Single Subject Research Protocol was created to provide a solid research design for EAGALA certified members to conduct outcome research in their programs. We encourage all practicing certified members to start implementing this tool and make it an integral part of your programs and practices to be conducting research.

The protocol provides information on how to conduct a single subject experiment with clients in your program or practice. It includes:

- General Instructions for the Protocol
- Information on Research Ethics and Informed Consent
- Informed Consent Form – General Form that can be Customized for your Program
- Description of Intervention including EAGALA Core Principles and Practices
- Information about Outcome Measures
- Information on Scoring and Plotting/Interpreting Data
